# HOMEBUYER UNIVERSITY

Homebuyer University is a five-class course taught by experts in the homebuying industry in a neutral, low-pressure setting. Together, we will cover the ins and outs of budgeting for, buying, and maintaining a home. At the end of the course, you will understand the entire homebuying process, and you will be ready to pursue your homeownership goals.

Homebuyer University is open to the public and anyone is welcome to enroll in the course. Homebuyer University is separate from our Affordable Homeownership Program and participation does not constitute a loan application with Habitat Chicago.
