

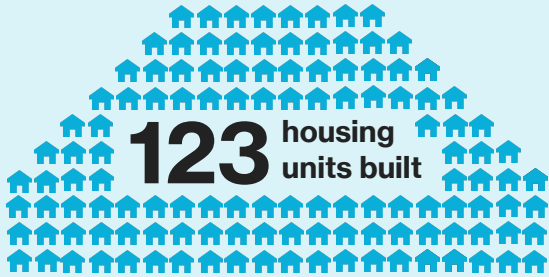

Affordable Homeownership Program

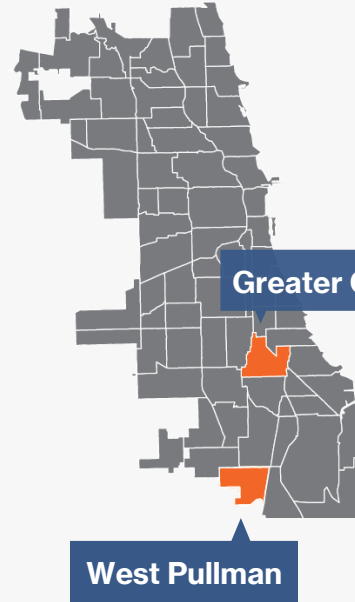


Through this robust program, households purchase a home with an affordable mortgage after fulfilling education hours and volunteer hours on the build site.

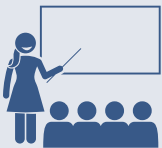
Our Focus Neighborhoods



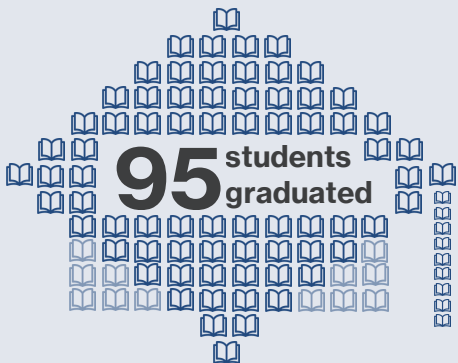
