Habitat Chicago will invest \$42 million directly into our focus neighborhoods and center our programmatic efforts around four strategic priorities to:

- Strengthen the neighborhood housing market
- Elevate the neighborhood appeal
- Connect the community
- Enhance the physical environment

This planned growth in neighborhood investment and programmatic delivery will allow us to more directly address racial equity and neighborhood disinvestment, giving thousands of residents of Chicago and our partner country, Malawi, a clear way to realize the Habitat vision – **one where everyone has a decent place to live.**

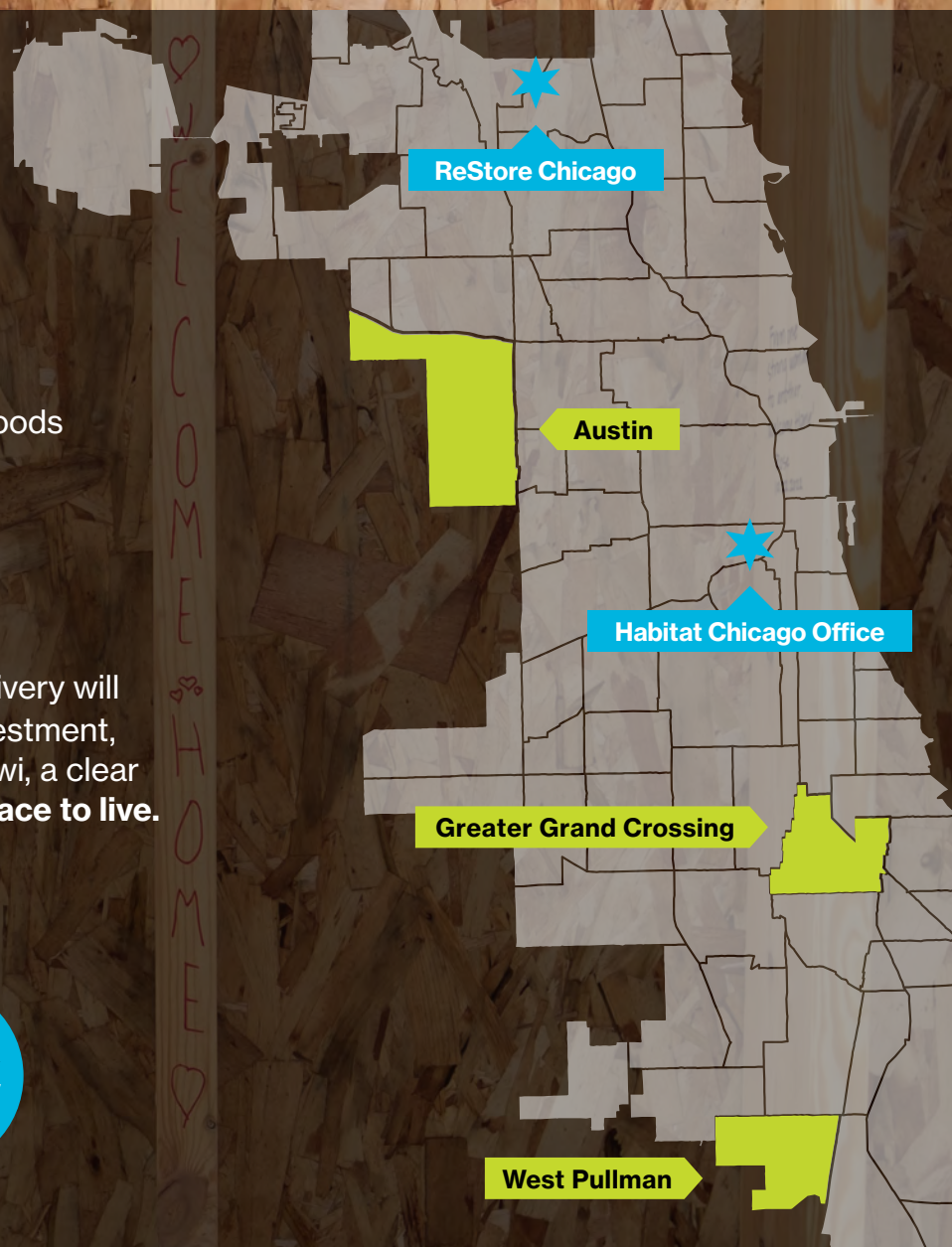

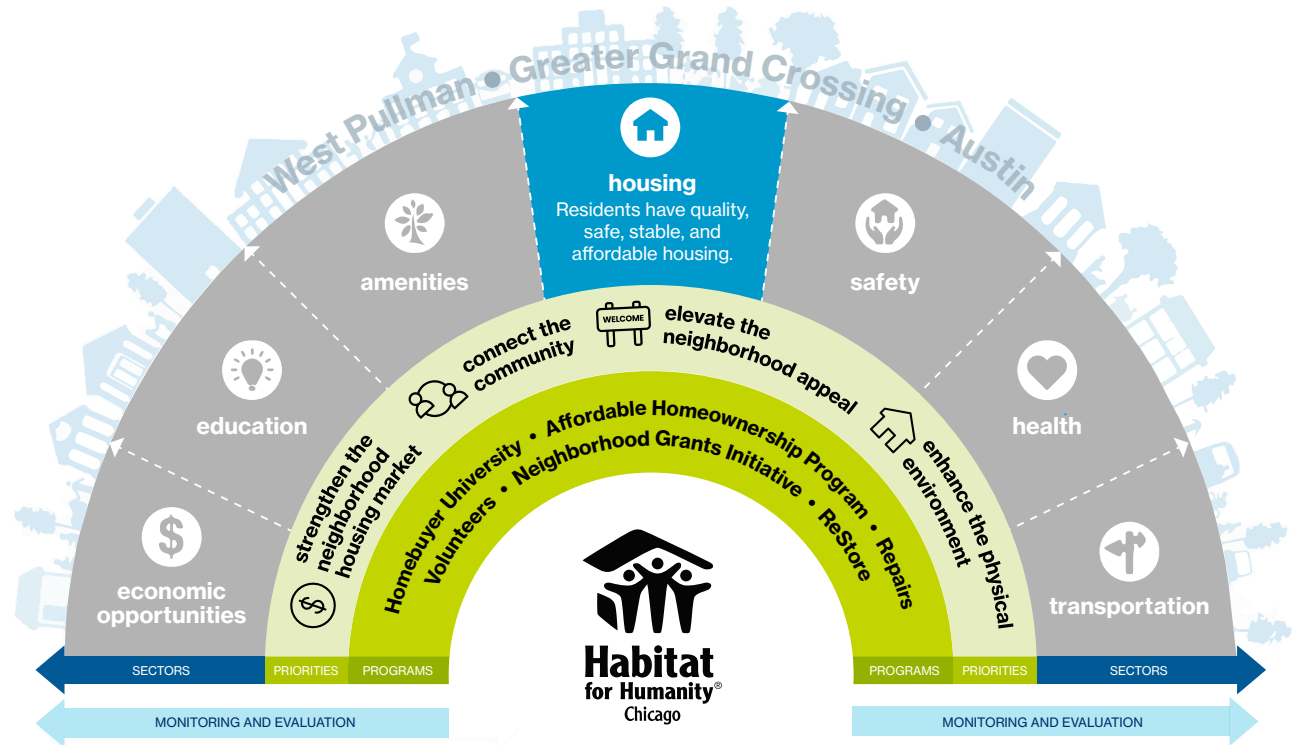

# what is a healthy neighborhood?

With the core belief that everyone deserves a decent place to live, **Habitat Chicago works to champion healthy, thriving neighborhoods by investing in resident priorities, building quality homes, and supporting homeownership.**

We define a healthy neighborhood as a place where residents are connected and have a strong sense of belonging, work cooperatively, drive ongoing work in the neighborhood, and have ready access to resources in seven key neighborhood sectors.

**Habitat Chicago invests specifically in the health of the housing sector.** These focused investments can have positive ripple effects into other neighborhood sectors, such as household economic stability and safety.



The above chart illustrates how multiple elements work together in the whole of an individual's environment and serve as fundamental components in ensuring healthy, thriving neighborhoods.

## 01

### strengthen the neighborhood housing market

Investments that create and retain homeowners bolster the neighborhood market, increasing property values, lowering resident turnover, and building generational wealth.

#### KEY TACTICS

- **Invest in new construction** that results in owner-occupied purchases
- **Preserve existing housing stock through rehab** for new homeowner purchase
- **Expand educational opportunities** to promote sustainable, long-term homeownership

## 02

### connect the community

Neighbors who feel connected to each other and to their community have increased capacity and desire to invest in their own neighborhood.

#### KEY TACTICS

- **Support resident-led projects and neighborhood vision** through our Neighborhood Grants Initiative
- **Participate in and support ongoing efforts of formal networks and existing institutions** for collective impact
- **Serve as a conduit to connect people** to resources and to each other





## 03

### elevate the neighborhood appeal

Safe, thriving environments boost resident confidence in their neighborhood's future, while also enticing new residents to the area.

#### KEY TACTICS

- **Enhance our volunteers program** to include asset-based and racial equity education
- **Foster neighborhood pride** through civic engagement and community-building events
- **Work in partnership with local organizations** to attract additional investment

### enhance the physical environment

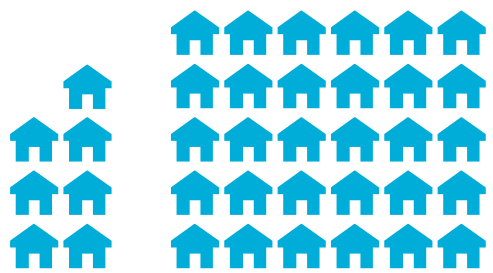
Neighborhoods that feel secure and inviting foster additional investment in quality community amenities.

- **Provide resources to homeowners for home maintenance** and critical repairs

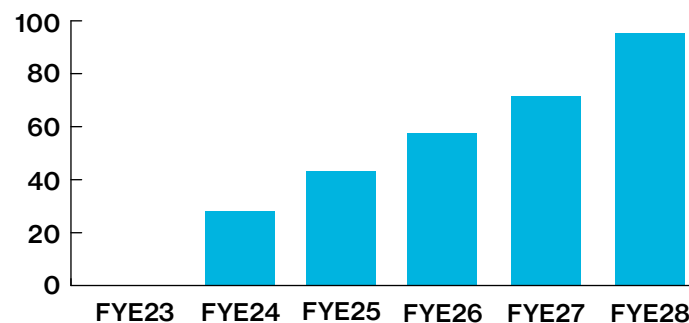

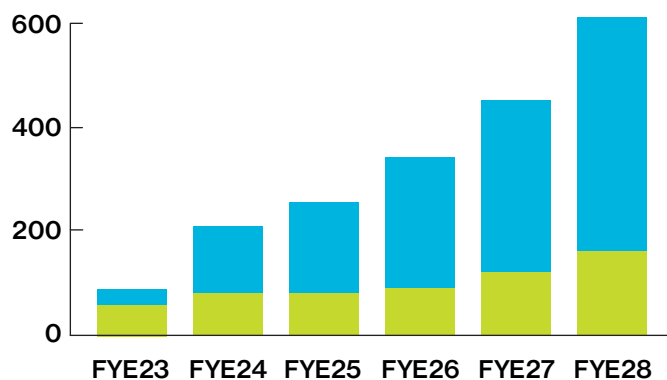

# activate advocacy platform

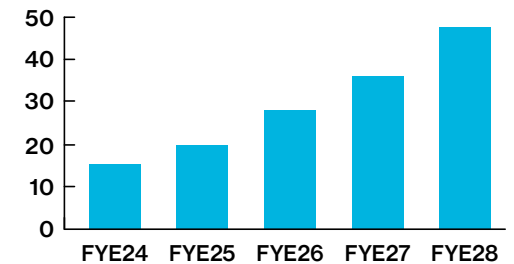
Advocating for systemic change and racial equity in housing will be the foundation of our work over the next five years. Together with those in the affordable housing and neighborhood investment spaces, our collective efforts will focus on policy and funding at the city, county, and state levels, while supporting national efforts through the Habitat for Humanity network.



## increase investment in Habitat Malawi

Habitat Chicago annually dedicates a portion of our revenue to Habitat Malawi, our international partner affiliate. This investment allows Habitat Malawi to build new homes, respond to natural disasters, and improve access to hygiene and water sanitation.
