

With the core belief that everyone deserves a decent place to live, **Habitat Chicago works to champion healthy, thriving neighborhoods by investing in resident priorities, building quality homes, and supporting homeownership.**

We define a healthy neighborhood as a place where residents are connected and have a strong sense of belonging, work cooperatively, drive ongoing work in the neighborhood, and have ready access to resources in seven key neighborhood sectors.

Habitat Chicago invests specifically in the health of the housing sector. These focused investments can have positive ripple effects into other neighborhood sectors, such as household economic stability and safety.

Investments that create and retain homeowners bolster the neighborhood market, increasing property values, lowering resident turnover, and building generational wealth.

KEY TACTICS

- **Invest in new construction** that results in owneroccupied purchases
- Preserve existing housing stock through rehab for new homeowner purchase
- **Expand educational opportunities** to promote sustainable, long-term homeownership

02 connect the community

Neighbors who feel connected to each other and to their community have increased capacity and desire to invest in their own neighborhood.

KEY TACTICS

- Support resident-led projects and neighborhood vision through our Neighborhood Grants Initiative
- Participate in and support ongoing efforts of formal networks and existing institutions for collective impact
- Serve as a conduit to connect people to resources and to each other

Neighborhoods that feel secure and inviting foster additional investment in quality community amenities.


KEY TACTICS

- Ensure accessibility and public works improvements in all new housing developments










increase investment in Habitat Malawi
